Proceeds from the 2010 Santa Clarita Century will be donated to the Santa Clarita Child & Family Center (childfamilycenter.org) and C.O.R.E. (corecentersinfo.com). The Child & Family Center helps build a healthy Santa Clarita Valley by providing mental health, behavioral and educational services to children, adults and their families. They provide mental health services, family support, early intervention mental health services for children (0Ñ5 years), and drug and alcohol treatment for teens. C.O.R.E. (Center of Rehabilitative Exercise) provides the opportunity for one to improve the quality of their life. It is a source, a catalyst, which attracts individuals, families, and friends to opportunities of physical health, mental motivation, and spiritual inspiration

Bike Expo

The bicycle expo, located at the start/finish will include displays from local shops and bike equipment suppliers. Exhibitors may provide products and services ranging from tech-support to souvenir items

Courses

Both courses, following the same beginning 25-miles, venture eastward, climbing up to Acton and playing in the foothills of Angeles National Forest. Riders diverge after Acton with Half Century riders returning downhill to Santa Clarita. The Century climbs a little farther into the mountains, before returning home via Newhall.

Half-Century, starting at 8am: 52 miles and approximately 2,400 feet of climbing

Century, starting at 7am: 100 miles with approximately 7,000 feet of climbing

Family Ride, 10:30am

The 6-mile Family Ride loops around town on our local bike paths. The first 100 riders will receive a ride t-shirt. On-line and day-of registration is available and there is no rider limit. Children are required to be accompanied by an adult who has completed a waiver for themselves and their children. Family Ride participants will be treated just as Century & Half Century riders with SAG support on the course. Back at the start, riders can enjoy the Bike Expo and post-ride lunch as they cheer on the returning 100- and 50-mile riders.

Registration

Registration includes: entry to bike expo, route slip for 50 or 100 mile ride, roving SAG and mechanical support, and food & water stops.

Waivers

All participants must complete a waiver. Parents will complete for their children.
